The Tracey Howe Scholarship is for students pursuing certain health care careers at Southeastern Community College (SCC) and Iowa Wesleyan University (IW). Multiple scholarships will be awarded. Applications are due April 1.

Eligibility: Eligible programs at SCC include Emergency Medical Services – Paramedic, Healthcare Technology Management and Respiratory Care. Eligible programs at IW include Nursing (BSN) and Psychology. This scholarship is open to students graduating from public or private schools based in Des Moines and Lee Counties. Nontraditional students that live in either Des Moines or Lee Counties are also eligible.

Tracey Howe Scholarship Details

Tracey Howe was a registered nurse at Fort Madison Community Hospital. In 2017, her family established a scholarship fund in her memory. Multiple scholarships are awarded each year.

Scholarship criteria

- Scholarships are financial aid for certain healthcare career education provided at local institutions.
- This scholarship is for students graduating from public or private schools in Des Moines and Lee Counties. Nontraditional students living in Des Moines and Lee Counties will also be considered.
- Students must attend Southeastern Community College or Iowa Wesleyan University. Eligible programs include:
 - Emergency Medical Services Paramedic (SCC)
 - Healthcare Technology Management (SCC)
 - Respiratory Care (SCC)
 - Nursing-BSN (IW)
 - Psychology (IW)
- LPN and RN students at SCC receive funding through other health system partnerships.
- Applicants with an RN transferring to IW to obtain a BSN degree are eligible.
- Awards are based on grades, leadership, character, community activities and financial need.

Application process

- Complete the scholarship application.
- Get a copy of your high school transcript for the past seven semesters (if applicable).
- Write an essay stating why you should receive the Tracey Howe Scholarship. Include how you meet the criteria, your career objectives and how you plan to meet them.
- Obtain letters of support from one professional and one personal reference who are not related to you.
- Make a copy of your estimated family contribution (EFC) from your FAFSA, or if you are a nontraditional student, copies of your last three federal income tax forms.
- Submit everything to Tracey Howe Scholarship, Great River Health Foundation, 5445 Avenue O, PO Box 174, Fort Madison, IA 52627.
- The deadline for all materials is April 1.

Award process

Scholarships will be announced at school award ceremonies in May or by email or telephone. Recipients will receive a check payable to the educational institution of their choice to be used for educational expenses.
