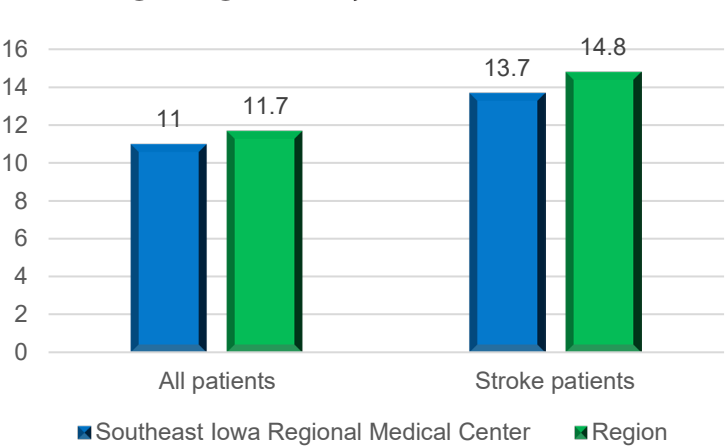

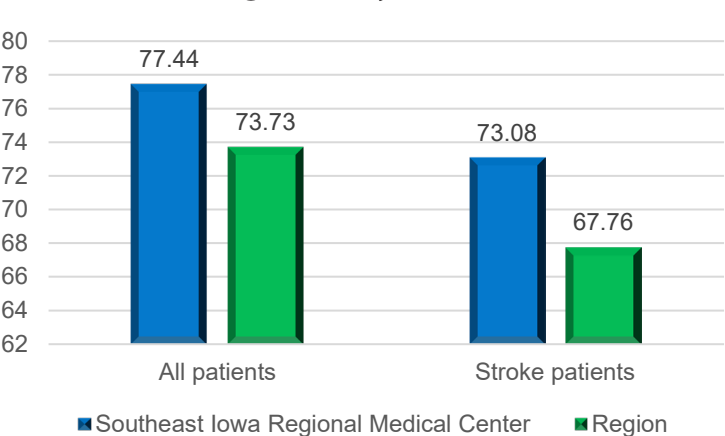

Average length of stay (lower is better)

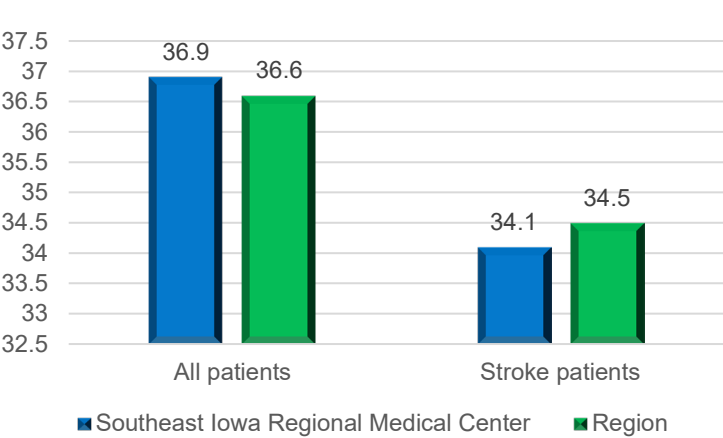


Functional Efficiency: Amount of improvement relative to length of stay (higher is better)

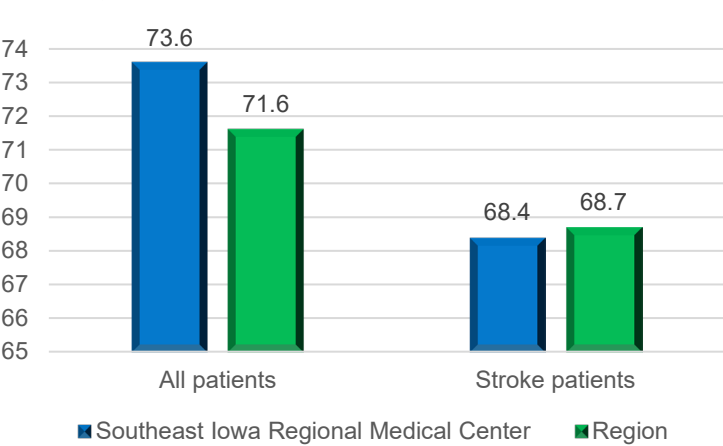


Effectiveness of the program: Discharge Score (higher is better)

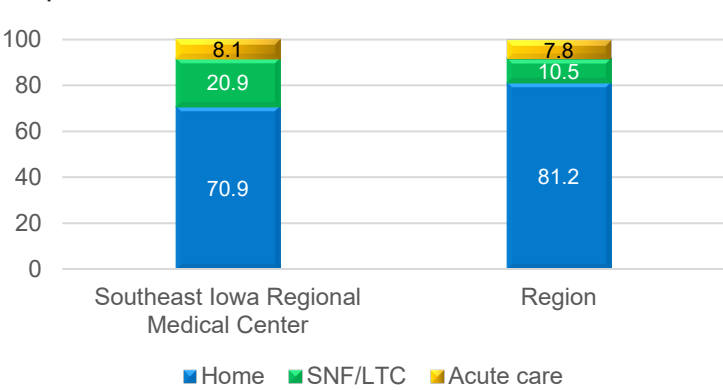


Mobility
